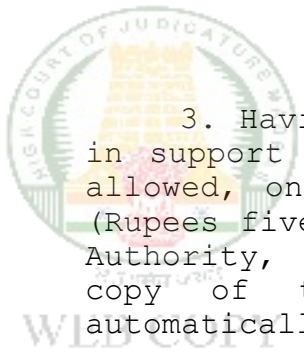
PRAYER IN C.M.A. SR No. 10537/2015 :
