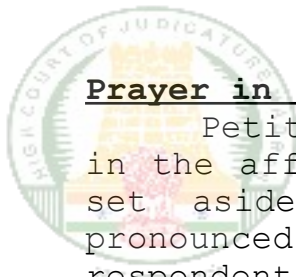

Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to direct the Deputy Registrar (Administration), High Court Madurai Bench to disburse to the 130 workers listed in the Writ Petition as part payment of the bonus for the year 2011-2012 , 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015 and wages upto the date of lock out and also to distribute the accumulated interest to the workers in proportion to the dues of each worker in WA.(MD).No.1122/2015.



Prayer in WA. (MD).No.1122/2015:

Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to set aside the order and judgment in WP(MD)No.10685 of 2015 pronounced on 16/10/2015 award costs to be borne by the first respondent.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.10685 of 2015:

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 2 & 3 to provide sufficient police protection for a specified period to enable the petitioner to remove the materials from the petitioner's factory site at Kumaramangalam Village, Mathur, Pudukottai District.

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.G.PORKODI KARNAN, Counsel for M/S.LAKSHMI GOPINATHAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of M/S.T.ANTONY ARULRAJ, Advocate for the 1st respondent and of M/S.A.K.BASKARA PANDIAN, Special Government Pleader, for the respondents 2 to 4, the court made the following order:-

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this Civil Miscellaneous Petition with liberty to file a fresh modified petition so as to enable the workers belonging to the Petitioner Sangam, to get disbursement of Rs.80,00,000/- deposited by the Management and she has also made an endorsement to that effect.

Accordingly, this Civil Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty as sought for by the petitioner.
