Prayer in C.M.P. (MD) No.7634 Of 2016:

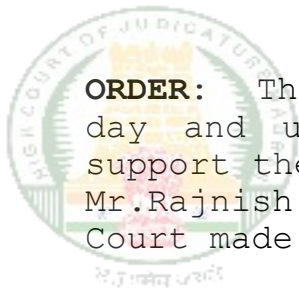
This Miscellaneous Petition is filed under Section 5 of Limitation Act, praying to condone the delay of 93 days in filing the Writ Appeal against the order passed in W.P.No.2221 of 2006 dated 30.11.2010.

W.A. (MD) SR.No.21909 Of 2011:

Writ Appeal is filed under clause 15 of the letter patent to prefer this memorandum of Grounds of Writ Appeal against the order passed by Honourable Mr.Justice S.Nagamuthu dated 30.11.2010 in WP (MD) No.2221 Of 2006.

Prayer in WP. (MD) No.2221 Of 2016:

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the order issued by the 2nd respondent in his proceedings in letter No.7486/Legal 90/TSTC/2005 dated 26/01/2006 and quash the same as illegal and consequently to direct the respondents to pay pensionary benefits to the petitioner forthwith.
