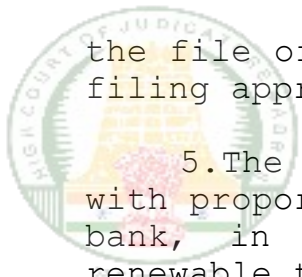
ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. N.SUDHAGAR NAGARAJ, Advocate for the petitioner and of M/S.P.PRABHAKARAN, Advocate on behalf of the Respondent the Court made the following order:-

The appellant/Transport Corporation would submit that as directed by this Court, they have deposited the entire award amount along with accrued interest and costs before the Tribunal.

2.Now the Petitioner herein/Claimant has filed the present application to withdraw 50% of the deposited award amount together with proportionate interest and costs lying in the credit of M.C.O.P.No.199 of 2012, on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal(Sub-Court), Karur.

3.The learned counsel for the respondent/Transport Corporation has no objection in allowing this application.

4.In view of the same, the Petitioner is permitted to withdraw 50% of the deposited award amount with proportionate accrued interest and costs lying in the credit of M.C.O.P.No.199 of 2012, on



the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Sub-Court), Karur, by filing appropriate application before the Tribunal.

5. The Tribunal is directed to deposit the balance award amount with proportionate interest and costs in any one of the nationalized bank, in fixed deposit, initially for a period of one year, renewable thereafter, till the disposal of the appeal.
