2. According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), on completion of trial, charge sheet has been **laid in P.R.C.No.13 of 2016.**

3. Considering the fact that charge sheet has been laid in P.R.c.No.13 of 2016, the condition already imposed on the petitioner is relaxed and he shall report before the committal Court and trial Court regularl on all dates of hearing, without fail.

4. The Magistrate is directed to expedite the matter and proceed with the same on a day-to-day basis and shall not adjourn the matter beyond two weeks at any point of time. Once the matter



is committed, the committal Court shall proceed with the matter on day-to-day basis without adjourning the matter beyond three weeks thereafter at any point of time and the petitioner shall co-operate with the trial.
