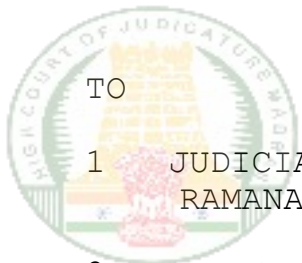
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) for the respondent.
