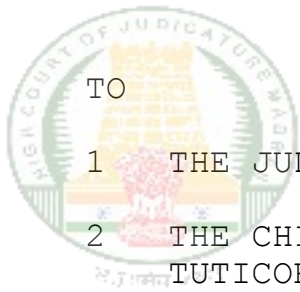
Heard both sides.
