ORDER

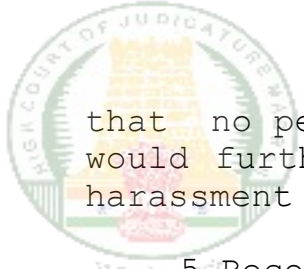
It is an application seeking a direction to the first and second respondents and their men not to harass the petitioners based on the complaints of the third and fourth respondents.
