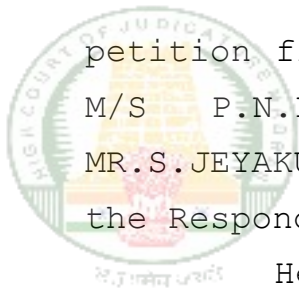

Prayer in CRL A(MD). 21/ 2013 : Memorandum of Grounds of Appeal against the judgment and conviction passed by his learned IInd Additional District Judge for CBI Cases, Madurai in C.C.No.1 of 2009 dated 28.12.2012 convicting the appellants for the offences under Section 120B,468,420 r/w 511 IPC sentenced them to undergo three years R1 and to pay a fine of Rs.3000/- each in default of payment of fine to undergo two months simple imprisonment.
