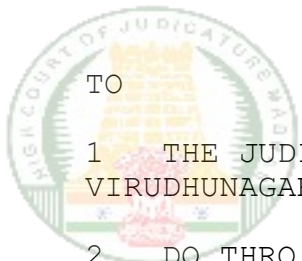
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side).
