Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side).

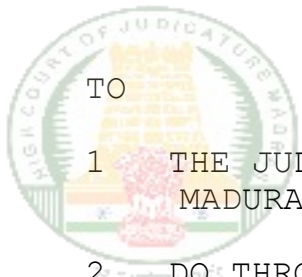
