The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has represented that the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

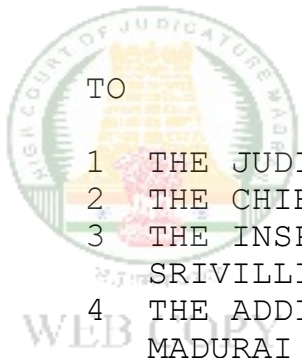
In view of the submission made, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
