Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners / Accused and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the State.

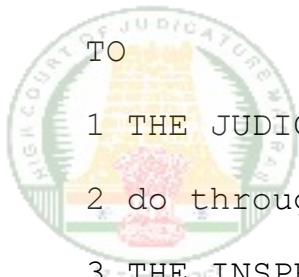
2. It is represented that the petitioners are complying with the condition regularly, without any adverse remarks.
