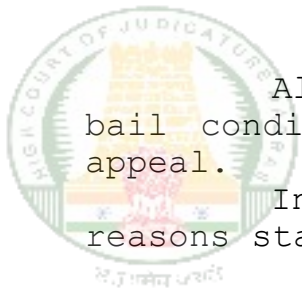
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 4251/ 2016 IN CRL A(MD) No.88 of 2014 :
