PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.24594 of 2015, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and now pending in S.T.C.No.532 of 2011 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, seeks anticipatory bail. The petitioner in Crl.O.P. (MD) No.24605 of 2015, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and now pending in S.T.C.No.432 of 2014 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, seeks anticipatory bail. The petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD) No. 24605 of 2015, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and now pending in S.T.C.No.432 of 2014 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, seeks anticipatory bail. The petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD) No. 24595 of 2015, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 408 IPC and now pending in C.C.No.247 of 2015 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, seeks anticipatory bail. The petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD) No. 24596 of 2015, who



apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 408 IPC and now pending in C.C.No.38 of 2012 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that due to the absence of the petitioner, non-bailable warrant was issued against the petitioner by the trial Court.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that due to absence of the petitioner, non-bailable warrant was issued against the petitioner and the petitioner may be directed to approach the Court for recalling the warrant.

4. Considering the fact that non-bailable warrant was issued against the petitioner for his absence, there shall be a direction, directing the petitioner to surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, and to file petitions for recalling the warrant and the learned Magistrate, is directed to consider the same on the same day and pass orders on merits in accordance with law.

5. Accordingly, the petitions are disposed of.
