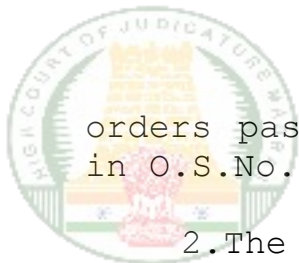

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, seeking a direction, directing the 1st respondent herein to direct the 2nd and 3rd respondents not to interfere with the civil disputes, pertaining to the property comprised in Survey No.80 measuring an extent of 4 acres on the western side situated at Megamalai Village, Andipatti Taluk, Theni District, on the basis of the
