O R D E R

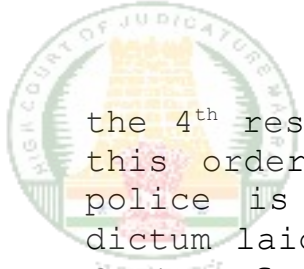
This petition is filed to direct the 2nd respondent to register the case on the basis of the petitioner's petition, dated 03.12.2015 and 04.12.2015.

the 4th respondent police and to give a fresh complaint along with this order and on receipt of such complaint, the 4th respondent police is directed to register the complaint by following the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]** and the 4th respondent police may conduct a preliminary enquiry, which shall not extend beyond a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In conducting the preliminary enquiry, they shall put the concerned parties upon notice. At the end thereof, if any cognizable offence is made out, they shall duly register a case. In the event of effecting closure of the case upon conducting a petition enquiry, a copy of the closure report shall be forwarded to the complainant.

5.The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
