Heard to learned Counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent.

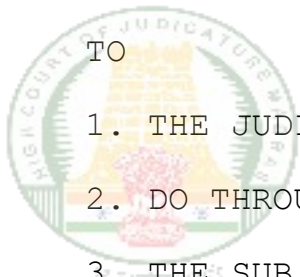
The petitioners are regularly complying with the conditions and he represented by a counsel in the revision.
