Heard both sides.

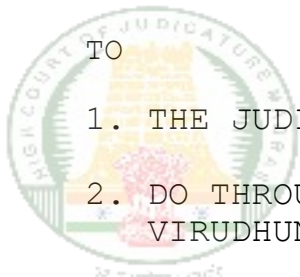
