The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioners are complying with the condition regularly.

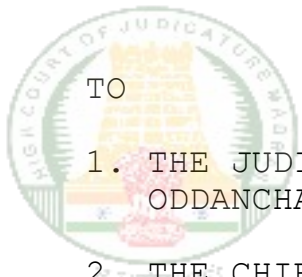
2. Considering the above submission, the condition already imposed on the petitioners totally relaxed.
