Heard both sides.

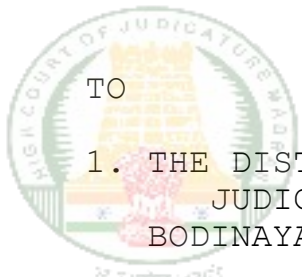
2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.
