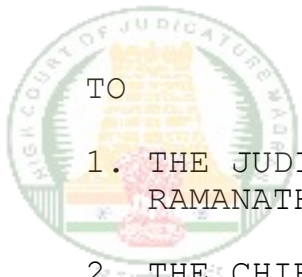
The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly and the charge sheet has been filed.
