Prayer in CRL OP(MD). 12959/ 2016 :

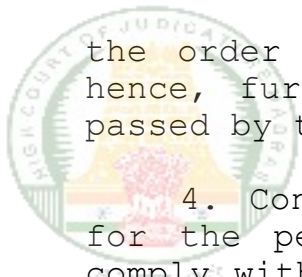
