2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioners are complying with the condition regularly.

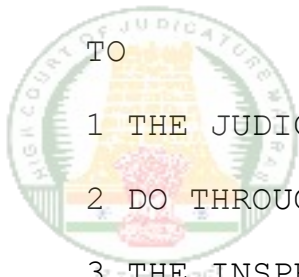
3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition imposed already on the petitioner is modified to the effect that the petitioners are directed to report before the respondent police as and when required.
