Heard both sides.

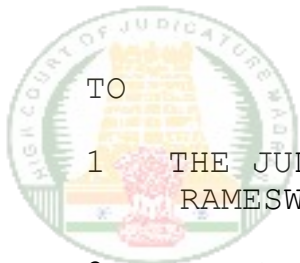
2 The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.
