Heard both sides.

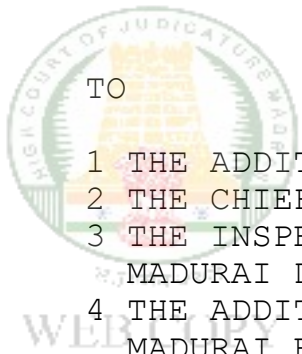
2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.
