2. The learned Government Advocate submitted that the petitioners are complying with the condition regularly without fail.

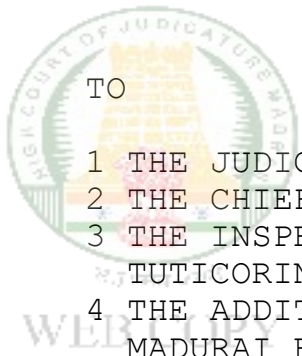
3.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed on the petitioners is totally relaxed.
