Heard both sides.

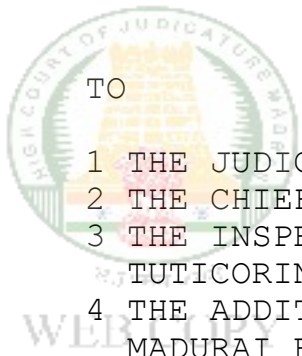
2.The learned Government Advocate submitted that the petitioners are complying with the condition regularly without fail.
