3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that even after a lapse of six months from the date of registration of the case, the second respondent did not take any efforts to file the final report. Hence, the petitioner has come up with this petition for the aforesaid prayer.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), on instructions, would submit that the second respondent requires



three months time to complete the investigation and to file the final report.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent to complete the investigation and to file the final report in Crime No.987 of 2015 before the Court concerned within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
