The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the petition and he has also made an endorsement to that effect.

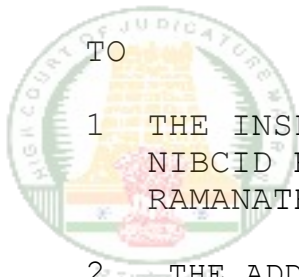
2. In view of the endorsement made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
