2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that on the basis of the complaint given by the de-fact complainant, petition enquiry has been conducted and closed.

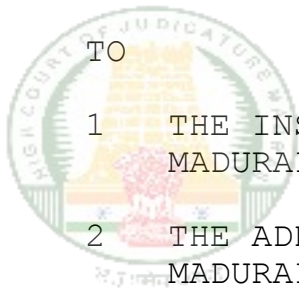
3. In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
