PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 147, 148, 447, 427, 294(b), 323, 506(ii) read with 109 and 384 IPC, in C.C.No.153 of 2015, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District, seek anticipatory bail.

2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that an absconding charge sheet has been filed against the petitioners and due to the absence of the petitioners, non bailable warrant was issued against them by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that due to absence of the petitioners for one hearing, non bailable warrant was issued against them and they may be directed to approach the Court for recalling the warrant.

4.Considering the fact that non bailable warrant was issued against the petitioners for their absence, there shall be a direction, directing the petitioner to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District and to file a



petition for recalling the warrant and the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District is directed to consider the same on the same day and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law.

5. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.
