3. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the complainant was withdrawn, upon settlement between the parties. Hence, nothing survives for adjudication.

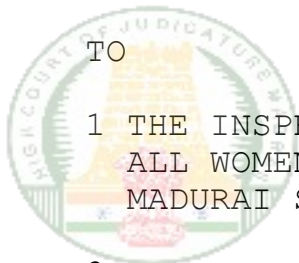
4. Upon considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that nothing survives for adjudication. Hence, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
