PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 to 13, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 227, 323, 324, 379(NP) IPC r/w Section 4 of Tamilnadu Women Harassment Act, in Crime No.146 of 2016, on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the petitioner is that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner is no way connected to the occurrence and their name have been falsely implicated in this case by the respondent police. The petitioners 3, 6 to 9 are students.



3.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) submitted that the petitioners have stolen 3 sovereigns of gold jewels and a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and the injured person is taking treatment as out patient.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are willing to deposit a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- together with a sum of Rs.75,000/- for the value of 3 sovereigns of gold jewels, totally Rs.1,75,000/- to the credit of Crime No.146 of 2016 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vadipatti, Madurai District.

5.Considering the nature of the allegation made against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, they are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vadipatti, Madurai District, on condition that the petitioners shall deposit a total sum of Rs.1,75,000/-(Rupees one lakh and seventy five thousand only) to the credit of Crime No.146 of 2016, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vadipatti, Madurai District, and they shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

- (i) the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
- (ii) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
- (iii) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
- (iv) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

6.The Inspector of Police concerned is directed to send a compliance report to the office of the learned Government Advocate, as to whether the petitioners are complying with the conditions or not.
