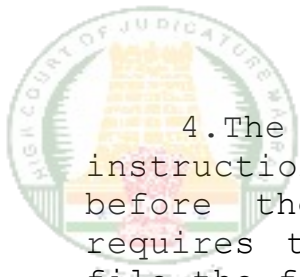

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that even after a lapse of two years and two months from the date of registration of the case, the 2nd respondent did not take any efforts to file the final report. Hence, the petitioner has come up with this petition for the aforesaid prayer.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), on instructions, would submit that the investigation is pending before the second respondent and that the second respondent requires three months time to complete the investigation and to file the final report in Crime No.344 of 2014.
