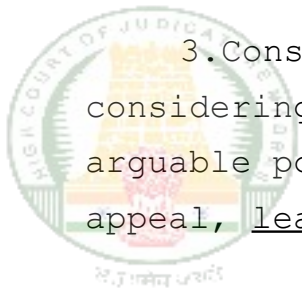
Prayer in CRL A(MD)NO.SR23192 OF 2016:
