ORDER

It is an application seeking a direction to the 1st respondent to instruct the 2nd respondent to register a case and file final report accordance with law in complaint dated 21.07.2016 pending before the respondents.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the intervenor and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is pending.



4. There is no contention that the nature of the complaint requires immediate registration of the case.

5. In view of the above, the 2nd respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the 2nd respondent shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**. During such enquiry, the intervenors/Pounraj and Ukkirapandi shall also be given an opportunity of hearing. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
