PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

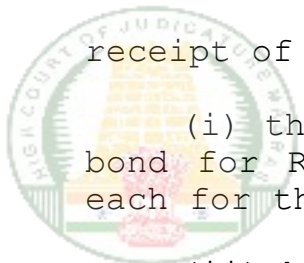
Petitioner/accused, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 286, 337, 304(A) IPC r/w Section 9(B)(1)(a) of Indian Explosives Act, 1884, in Crime No.249 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2.Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is a licensed manufacturer of fire works. Owing to negligence of employees, a minor explosion took place resulting in death of one and injury to another and injured person stands discharged. Towards the family of the deceased, the petitioner has paid Rs.4,50,000/- to the wife of the deceased and the petitioner's license initially was suspended and now stands revoked.

3.Heard Government Advocate (Crl.Side) on the above submission.

4. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;



receipt of a copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the likesum to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioner shall be available for interrogation by the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for two weeks and thereafter as and when required.
