PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, pray for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Section 498(A) IPC on the file of the respondent police.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner married the de facto complainant on 11.09.2006. Due to demand of additional dowry, the de facto complainant preferred the present complaint.

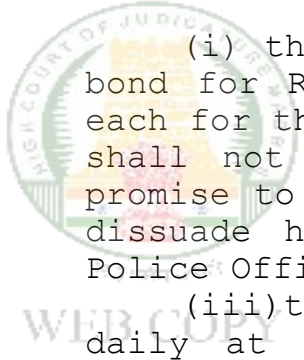
3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side).

5.On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Additional Mahila Court, Madurai, within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order,



(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the likesum to their satisfaction; (ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for two weeks and thereafter as and when required.
