PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner/accused, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 342, 323, 324, 379(NP) and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.337 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner attacked the defacto complainant with knife and took a sum of Rs.4,600/- from the pocket of the defacto complainant and also criminally intimidated him.

3. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and the petitioner is involved in 10 other cases.

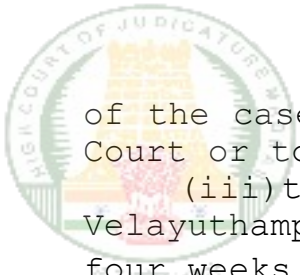
4. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Eraniel within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties <https://search.eCourts.gov.in/e-services> to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact



of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioner shall stay at Karur and report before Velayuthampalayam Police Station, daily at 10.30 am for a period of four weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.
