2. Mr. A. Ramar, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, produced a copy of the Government Order containing the revocation order. The revocation order came to be passed in G.O. Rt. No. 5978, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIV) Department, dated 21.09.2015.

3. As the order of detention has been revoked, the Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
