2. Heard learned counsel appearing for petitioner and learned
Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondents.

3. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side),
the petitioner has given a complaint and the same is pending
investigation.

4. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted
that the petition is only not to harass the petitioner.

5. Whatever might be the circumstances, there shall be no
harassment to the petitioner, but let the police investigate into
the matter in accordance with law and the mandates as found set
out in ***D.K.Basu Vs.State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC***

police to issue summons to the petitioner. Thereupon, the petitioner shall appear before the police and submit himself for interrogation. The petitioner is also permitted to take the assistance of the Advocate to the limited extent as found envisaged in the precedent cited supra.
