PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner, who was arrested on 11.07.2016 for offence punishable under Section 5 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 in Crime No.3 of 2015 on the file of respondent police, seeks bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police and perused the papers including the counter affidavit filed by the respondent.

3. The case of the prosecution is that a bicycle was parked and chained to the iron grill of the compound wall of Ram Temple near Gupta Auditoriam. A box fitted on the bicycle resulted in a blast on 01.05.2012.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of occurrence of the year 2012, the petitioner has been arrayed as accused only on 11.07.2015 on the basis of confession of one Samsudheen, who is an accused in a different case and there were as many as 8 such incidents in and around Madurai City. This Court, in



granting bail to the accused in one of such cases, under orders in Crl.O.P.Nos. 12635 and 12636 of 2015, had taken note also of the position that the communication dated 29.03.2013 of the Superintendent of Police to the Director General of Police indicated that not all was well with the police department.

5. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the petitioner has no previous case.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond in a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No. IV, Madurai, and on condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily twice at 10.00 a.m and 5.00 p.m until further orders.
