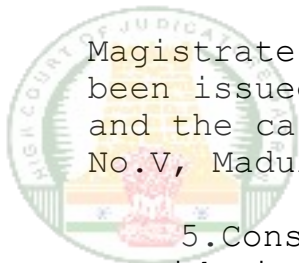
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.3 was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 31.05.2016 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147,148,294(b),307 r/w. 149 of IPC, in PRC.No.55 of 2014 (Crime No.492 of 2012), on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate V, Madurai and hence, seeks bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to non-appearance of the petitioner before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai, on 22.12.2014, non-bailable warrant was issued against him and thereafter, he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody. He further submitted that due to the death of petitioner's relative, he did not attend the Court on that day and he is in judicial custody from 31.05.2016 and prayed for enlarging the petitioner on bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioner was already granted bail and subsequently he jumped out of bail and due to his non-appearance before the learned Judicial



Magistrate No.V, Madurai, on 22.12.2014, non-bailable warrant has been issued against him and thereafter, he was secured on 31.05.2016 and the case has been pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai in PRC.No.55 of 2014.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 31.05.2016, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond in a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai and on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent Police daily at 10.00 am until further orders, except the date on which the trial will be conducted.
