PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

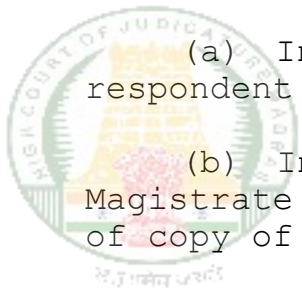
Petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, pray for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 457 and 427 IPC in Crime No.212 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that already co-accused was arrested and enlarged on bail.

4.Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that the petitioners and other accused trespassed into the premises of the de facto complainant and damaged the building worth of Rs.1,50,000/- by using JCB vehicle.

5.On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;



(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Dindigul, within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on each of them executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each to the credit of Crime No.212 of 2016.

(iii) petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iv) petitioners shall report before the concerned Court on every Monday at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
