PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, prays for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Section 174(3) Cr.P.C., subsequently, altered into 306 of I.P.C., in Crime No.211 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the husband of the deceased is a drunkard and he continuously tortured the deceased and at one point of time, she committed suicide by hanging. Hence, the case was registered.

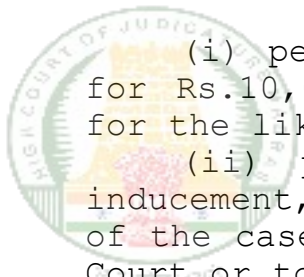
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased and she has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) .

5.On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Sivagangai within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,



(i) petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) Petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required.
