PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, pray for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 188 of I.P.C., r/w. Section 279 of I.P.C., in Crime No.418 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 11.09.2016, the petitioners along with others without obtaining permission from the respondent police went to the memorial ground of Imanuvelsekarn's Jeyanthi by using two wheeler.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) .

5.On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi within 15 days from the date of receipt of



(i) petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) Petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five hundred only) each to the Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Authority within three days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

(iii) petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iv) Petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required.
