PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

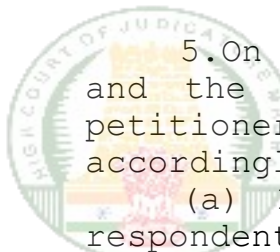
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, pray for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 354 & 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.254 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners along with other accused attacked the de facto complainant with deadly weapons and caused injury.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that as against A1 to A5 several cases are pending and in respect of A6 to A8 no case is pending.



5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners 6 to 8 can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukottai, within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) petitioners 6 to 8 shall be enlarged on bail on each of them executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) petitioners 6 to 8 shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) petitioners 6 to 8 shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for two weeks and thereafter as and when required.

6. In respect of petitioners 1 to 5 are concerned, this Criminal Original petition is dismissed.
