PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioners/accused, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C for the offences punishable under Sections 506(i), 507, 509 IPC and Section 67(B)(b) of Information Technology Act and Sections 11 and 12 POCSO Act, 2012 in Crime No.19 of 2016 on the file of respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the first accused disseminated photos of the daughter of the defacto complainant through internet.

3.Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case.

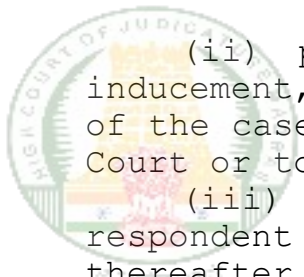
4.Heard learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side).

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukkottai, Virudhunagar District, within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on each of them executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;



(ii) petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) petitioners shall be available for interrogation by the respondent police daily at 10.30. am for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required.
