PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioners who are arrayed as accused, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.251 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners abused with filthy language and beaten with sticks and threatened with dire consequences.

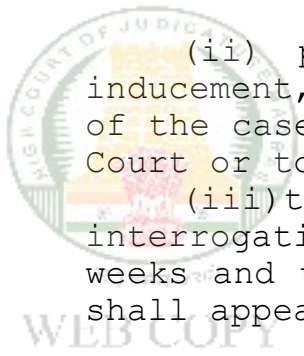
3. Leaned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the injured has been discharged from hospital.

4. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the Judicial Magistrate No.V, Tirunelveli, within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on each of them executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the likesum to their satisfaction;



(ii) petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioners 1 and 3 shall be available for interrogation by the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for two weeks and thereafter as and when required and the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required.
